## **New Ministry! Praying for Vocations**

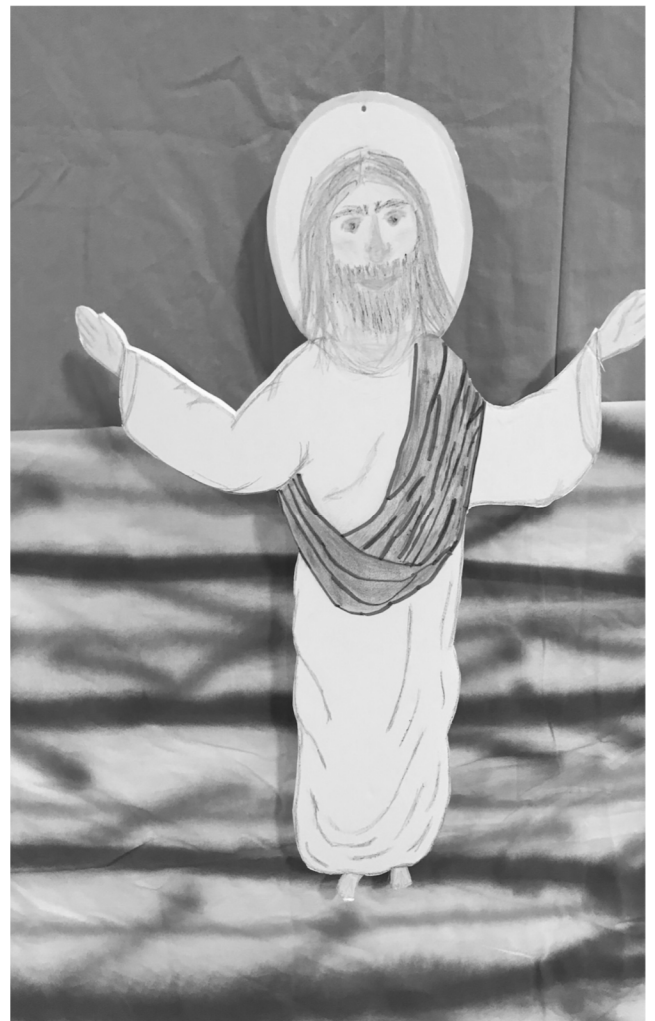
