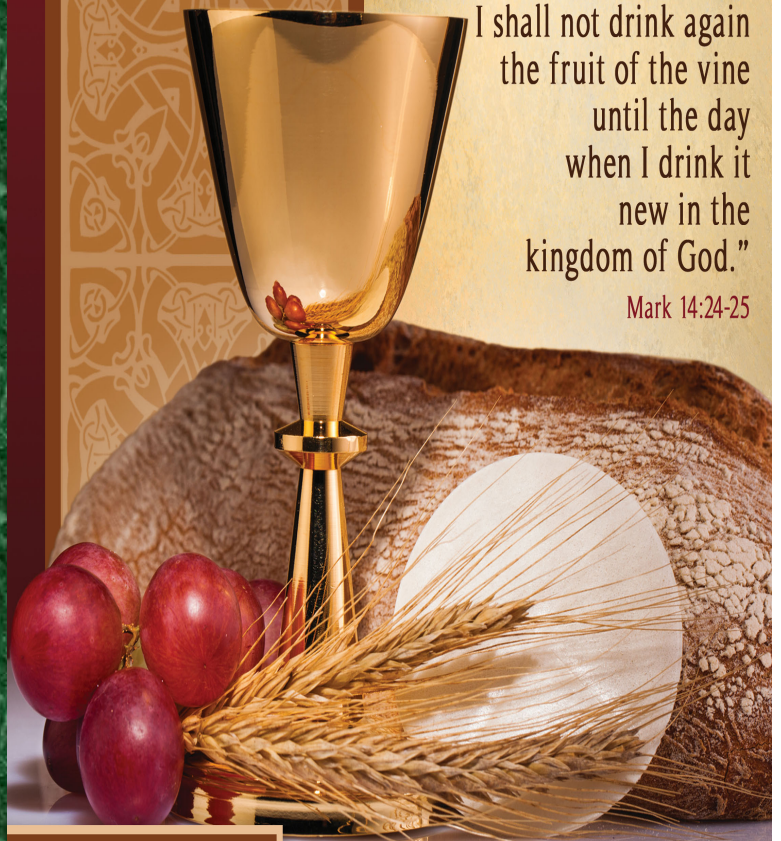

## **Corpus Christi**

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

**The solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ is also known as Corpus Christi. This feast originated in France in the mid thirteenth century (1263) after Fr. Peter of Prague, while offering Mass had a Eucharistic miracle. He had a deep conflict within himself believing the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. In 1264, a year later, Pope Urban IV declared this as the feast of the universal Church. This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus on the Eucharist—the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with the members of the same body.**

**This feast also invites us to understand the depth of God's love and his desire to be with us always—in the Eucharist. The greatest teaching on the Eucharist is given by Jesus himself in John 6. On a feast like this, we should spend time in reading, meditating, and understanding this great gift. How should I prepare myself for one who desires to commune with me and become part of me in the Eucharist? Is my heart ready for him to come and dwell in me? Thank God if you are ready, but if not we must cleanse our souls from any possible impurities and then receive him. How should I go to meet him as a member of his body (the Church) to participate in the most Holy Sacrifice. The Eucharist is nothing but Jesus' passion, suffering, death and Resurrection. The Lord made such a great sacrifice for us, giving himself up on the cross. What are the sacrifices we make for Him in turn? Do I make an hour of fast before the Mass? Do I dress modestly—a dress that you would wear for Jesus who gave up everything for you—a dress that would edify and strengthen the faith of other members of the body of Christ? Let us ask ourselves, why do I wear what I wear—is my entire self pleasing to the Lord—both internally (inner disposition) and externally (my appearance)? Do I lead other members of the body of Christ to the Head—Jesus himself—or am I a cause of distraction—or seeking attention to myself? How do I approach the sanctuary of the church, the Tabernacle, or when Jesus is exposed in the monstrance? I pray that we as a community grow in love and reverence for the Lord in the Eucharist—in His precious Body and Blood. May the Lord Bless and protect us from the evils of vanity and irreverence.**

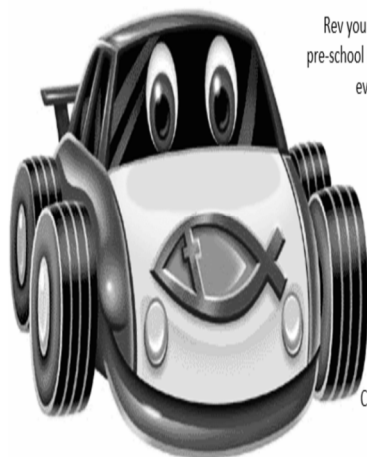
