"But from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh, so they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate." We live at a time, more than ever, where the very character of Holy Matrimony is questioned, distorted and at times destroyed by selfish interests against the intention of God. The center of Holy Matrimony is Unity and Indissolubility. It's not a contract but a covenant sealed by the Holy Spirit.
