Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We gathered at the Bicentennial Park in downtown Mooresville for the first time to pray together as a community to proclaim what we believe. It's a great sign of God's intervention and an answer to our prayers for the town of Mooresville and surrounding areas; and that too, in the month of October through the powerful intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary. As believers, disciples, and brothers of Jesus Christ we need to hold the hands of our Blessed Mother. The Apostles, after Our Lord was taken up to heaven, gathered around Blessed Mother and she held them together. Individuals must have no Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance, meet specific income criteria (such as a level of income for a family of four at \$50,200), and show proof of Morgan County residency.

Call 317.831.1697 with questions or to schedule an appointment on the first or third Saturday of each month between 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Patients receive a medical exam from a Nurse Practitioner or Physician, lab tests, radiology tests, and medications as necessary, all at no charge.

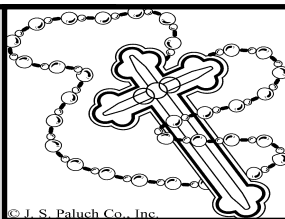
