## **29th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

**Wednesday, Oct. 17 we celebrated the feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, who became a martyr for his faith in Jesus Christ. He was arrested and killed most probably during the reign of the Roman Emperor Trajan. The details of Ignatius' death are lost to history but not his desire to have his life count for something. "Now I begin to be a disciple...let fire and cross, flocks of beasts, broken bones, dismemberment...come upon me, so long as I attain to Jesus Christ!" However, in the Gospel this weekend, the mother of James and John comes to Jesus for a favor of being placed at his right and left in His kingdom. They hardly knew what they were asking for. They were thinking in terms of how the Gentiles ruled, with royal privileges and honors. But the road to Christ's Kingdom is by way of His cross. To share this glory, we must be willing to drink the cup that He drinks. The cup is an OT image for God's judgment. The wicked would be made to drink this cup in punishment for their sins. But Jesus has come to drink this cup on behalf of all humanity. He has come to be baptized—which means plunged or immersed—into the sufferings we all deserve for our sins. Very often, we seek privileges without fulfilling our responsibilities toward the Church or society or government. The Call to Christian discipleship is nothing less than the Way of the Cross. The martyrs of the Church show us the Way after Christ's Cross and continue to inspire us. May we follow in His steps.**

Call 317.831.1697 with questions or to schedule an appointment on the first or third Saturday of each month between 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Patients receive a medical exam from a Nurse Practitioner or Physician, lab tests, radiology tests, and medications as necessary, all at no charge.
