## 1st Sunday of Advent

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It's so hard to believe we are on a new Liturgical year with the first Sunday of Advent. Advent means "advenire" in Latin, meaning "to come to". It's a season encompassing four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up the celebration of Christmas. It's a time of preparation of our hearts and minds for Christ's second coming at the end time and also the anniversary of Jesus' birth on Christmas. The final days of Advent, from December 17 to 24, focus particularly on our preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of Our Lord. It's customary to place Advent wreaths in our homes and churches, and the four candles placed on the wreath represent the four Sundays of Advent. The three purple candles symbolize the prayer, penance and preparatory sacrifices and good works undertaken at this time. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday, Gaudete Sunday, called a Sunday to Rejoice. The priest also wears rose vestments. The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding Our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead. As I invite you to spend this time in solid preparation, I encourage all who can make it to daily mass during this season to do so, as that is one of the best ways to prepare ourselves. We have several opportunities to serve the Lord in our neighbors, especially the needy.

May the Lord bless you and keep you.

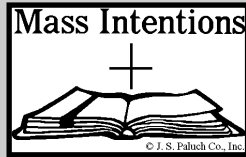

## CHRISTMAS COOKIE/CANDY SALE

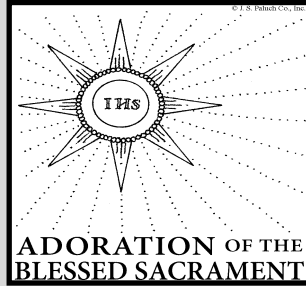
High School Youth are sponsoring a Christmas Cookie/Candy Sale

Call 317.831.1697 with questions or to schedule an appointment on the first or third Saturday of each month between 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Patients receive a medical exam from a Nurse Practitioner or Physician, lab tests, radiology tests, and medications as necessary, all at no charge.

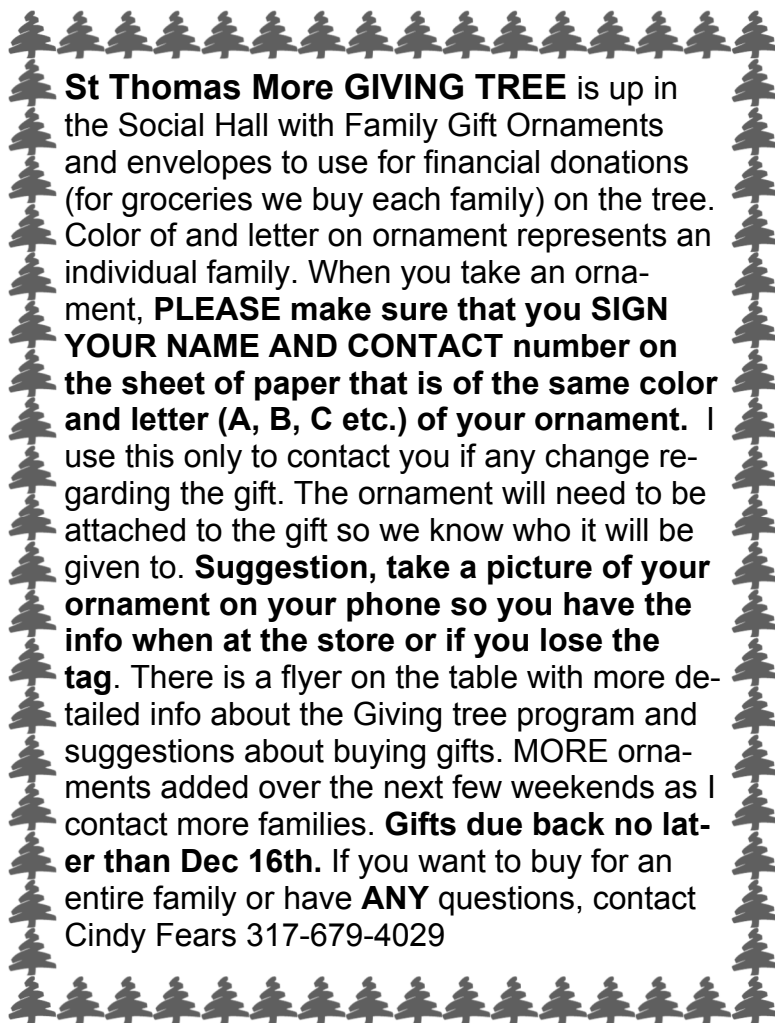
