Pentecost Sunday Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Acts 1:4,5,8: While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; ‘For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit’...But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth.”

The Holy Spirit is the lifegiving principle for every Christian; without Him it is not possible to live in Christ. So the Holy Spirit is someone essential to your Christian life.

The Gospel of John Chapter 16 verses 15ff tells us of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit and how the Holy Spirit guides every Christian. For everyone who loves God obeys his commandments. On Pentecost Sunday when Peter preached such a great homily that word of God cut through their hearts and they asked, “What must we do” in order to receive this power, Peter told them, ‘Repent and be baptized.’

Baptism in the Holy Spirit is an action of God, invited by an individual through prayer which brings about a deeper conversion to Christ, and which gives the Holy Spirit permission to work in that individual’s life in a more powerful way. This powerful action of the Holy Spirit is often accompanied by the ‘charisms’ or ‘gifts’ of the Holy Spirit as we find in the book of the Acts of the Apostles and letters of Paul. This is what the apostles and God’s people experienced on Pentecost. This helps us understand the need for a new strength, a new energy, a new grace in all of us to be Jesus’ witnesses in the world. May this Pentecost help us to live ‘through’, ‘with’, and ‘in’ Christ Jesus.

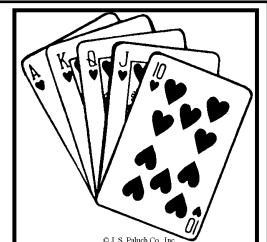

Individuals must have no Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance, meet specific income criteria (such as a level of income for a family of four at \$50,200), and show proof of Morgan County residency.

Call 317.831.1697 with questions or to schedule an appointment on the first or third Saturday of each month between 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Patients receive a medical exam from a Nurse Practitioner or Physician, lab tests, radiology tests, and medications as necessary, all at no charge.
