June 23, 2019 The Feast of Corpus Christi

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, historically known by its name Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. This feast dates back to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle. This feast is a solemn commemoration of the institution of that sacrament. It is moreover, the Church’s official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist, gave to the Church her greatest treasure. The Mass and the office for the feast were composed by St. Thomas Aquinas upon the request of Pope Urban IV in the year 1264. Though this feast began to be celebrated only from the 13th century, it began with the institution of the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist as early as the Last Supper Jesus celebrated with His apostles before He suffered and died. It was celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. On Sept. 8, 1264 Pope Urban IV instituted this feast as a feast of the Universal Church. In most countries this feast has been transferred to Sunday after the feast of Holy Trinity Sunday. Every parish is encouraged to hold a procession with the Blessed Sacrament exposed around the parish church, thus declaring publicly our faith in the precious body and blood of Jesus Christ.

May our faith in and love for the Eucharist be deepened as we celebrate the Feast of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

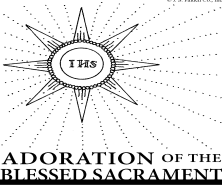

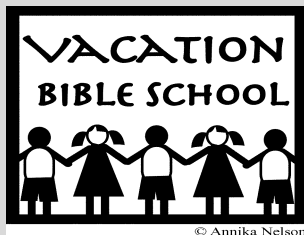

Individuals must have no Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance, meet specific income criteria (such as a level of income for a family of four at \$50,200), and show proof of Morgan County residency.

Call 317.831.1697 with questions or to schedule an appointment on the first or third Saturday of each month between 8:00 am - 1:00 pm. Patients receive a medical exam from a Nurse Practitioner or Physician, lab tests, radiology tests, and medications as necessary, all at no charge.
