Dear Brothers and Sisters,

My heart overflows with immense gratitude to each of you who walked an extra mile to be with me in prayerful support through beautiful sympathy cards with moving notes. Thank You very much.

My mum was given a great farewell and funeral service with at least 1000 people, more than 20 priests, and over 30 religious nuns belonging to different religious orders participating. My family is so blessed by your prayerful support. I am also grateful to the wonderful staff of STM and St. Ann for dealing with my absence from the parishes. Thank you Women of STM for organizing the memorial Mass and dinner which will be held Sunday, July 21 at 2:00 pm.

I do not know if I shared with you in the past, but my mother was the one who stood by me in my pursuit of the priesthood. My dad objected to me joining the seminary because according to custom the youngest son has to take care of the parents in their old age. It was she who convinced my dad that if I had the calling to let me be a priest to serve the Lord and the Church. She proudly told everyone who visited her that she had a priest son and a nun daughter. Even on the very last day of her life, as she was being taken to the ICU as she had developed some pulmonary and cardiac issues, she was calling for me and asked my oldest brother to inform me, which he did, even before she was taken to the hospital. She left a legacy of Great faith, courage and perseverance in enduring challenges in life. She continues to intercede for me and for all those whom I serve as a priest. May God reward her for her faithfulness to Him.

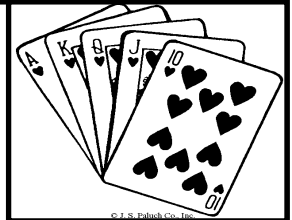

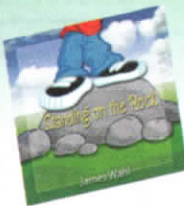
