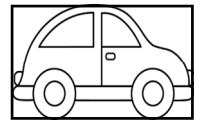

40 DAYS FOR LIFE: THE BEGINNING OF THE END OF ABORTION

Since 2007, 40 Days for Life participants report 14,636 lives saved from abortion during a campaign. That's the type of impact that led an ACLU spokesperson to describe 40 Days for Life as the "greatest threat to choice." But it's not just lives that are being saved. Souls are being won for God as well. Amidst the sixth 40 Days for Life campaign in Bryan/College Station, Abby Johnson — Planned Parenthood's employee of the year — changed her mind about abortion, and she turned to the 40 Days for Life team for encouragement as she left her job. Abby isn't alone. Less than a year later, 40 Days for Life came to Sherman, Texas, leading Ramona Trevino to leave her job managing a Planned Parenthood. These two Texans are among 172 abortion workers to experience conversion and leave their jobs through 40 Days for Life. 40 Days for Life has contributed to a groundswell of pro-life support worldwide. Some 96 abortion centers (and numerous referral centers) where campaigns have been hosted have closed their doors forever. The Bryan/College Station Planned Parenthood joined the list in 2013. The building where thousands of lives were taken has been redeemed and now serves as the international headquarters for 40 Days for Life. With God's grace, this movement will continue until every abortion center goes out of business for good.

To kick off 40 Days, **we will be viewing the movie "Unplanned" in the social hall on Sept 22 at 9:00am.** The ENTIRE PARISH is invited. High school classes are encouraged to attend. A sign up sheet will be available to go to the Georgetown Rd Planned Parenthood to pray sometime during the 40 days.

ST. ANN MISSION APPEAL—SISTERS OF MARY IMMACULATE SEPT. 14 & 15

Our religious community was founded in Kenya by Bishop Filipo Perlo and three women in 1918. Bishop Perlo, an Italian missionary, believed that anyone who would become part of the new community would walk in the footsteps of Jesus in caring for the poor, the needy, and the suffering. Today, more than 400 sisters actively serve in teaching, healthcare, pastoral care, and a variety of social ministries in the US, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, and Italy.

In Kiamumbi, one of Nairobi's outlying neighborhoods, children live in squalid slum conditions and are often orphaned, neglected and abused. For this reason, Maria Immaculata Children's Education Center serves as a beacon of hope. Founded in 1997 by the Sisters of Mary Immaculate, this combined home and school helps the area's neediest children grow into healthy, productive members of society. Its mission is to instill moral and spiritual values through care, encouragement, education and community intervention. Mary Immaculata Children's Education Center helps children realize their full potential and rise above the difficult socioeconomic circumstances from which they come.

We appeal for your support that we can continue with our ministries to these youngsters so that they can have a brighter future.
