Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When Moses was up on the mountain to receive the Decalogue and was delayed in his return, the people of Israel made a molten calf and began to worship it. The people couldn't wait for their leader Moses; they were focused on celebrating their escape from the hands of the Egyptians. The people had forgotten the fact that it was the Lord with His Mighty Hand who brought them out of Egypt. What they thought was right was not right. On a home visit, a Catholic woman told me that she was going to a particular denominational church because they made her 'feel good'. If we feel good, we generally tend to think it is good. To the first parents the forbidden fruit was pleasing to their eyes. However, we know what they fell for. "All that glitters is not gold". The prophetic role given to each of us is so very critical in our profession of faith. Each of us are called to be prophets who will teach the truth of the Kingdom of God, the Gospel. Jesus' teachings were not meant to make people 'feel good' or 'look good' but were the truths of the Kingdom of God which the Heavenly Father wanted Him to proclaim. In the eyes of the Pharisees, Jesus was a blasphemer; but in the eyes of the Father-He was His Beloved Son in whom He was well pleased.

There have been some changes happening in the organizational levels in various committees/councils in both parishes. Some of us are used to conducting our meetings in a particular way, which was good. However, there is always room for growth and development for each of the commissions and I appreciate your generosity with your time, talent and treasure with your respective churches. 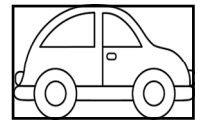

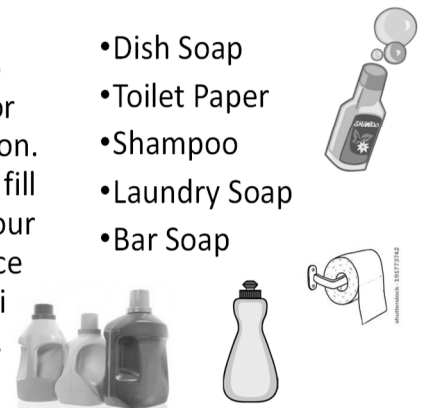

## 40 DAYS FOR LIFE: THE BEGINNING OF THE END OF ABORTION

Since 2007, 40 Days for Life participants report 14,636 lives saved from abortion during a campaign. That's the type of impact that led an ACLU spokesperson to describe 40 Days for Life as the "greatest threat to choice." But it's not just lives that are being saved. Souls are being won for God as well. Amidst the sixth 40 Days for Life campaign in Bryan/College Station, Abby Johnson — Planned Parenthood's employee of the year — changed her mind about abortion, and she turned to the 40 Days for Life team for encouragement as she left her job. Abby isn't alone. Less than a year later, 40 Days for Life came to Sherman, Texas, leading Ramona Trevino to leave her job managing a Planned Parenthood. These two Texans are among 172 abortion workers to experience conversion and leave their jobs through 40 Days for Life. 40 Days for Life has contributed to a groundswell of pro-life support worldwide. Some 96 abortion centers (and numerous referral centers) where campaigns have been hosted have closed their doors forever. The Bryan/College Station Planned Parenthood joined the list in 2013. The building where thousands of lives were taken has been redeemed and now serves as the international headquarters for 40 Days for Life. With God's grace, this movement will continue until every abortion center goes out of business for good.

To kick off 40 Days, **we will be viewing the movie "Unplanned" in the social hall on Sept 22 at 9:00am.** The ENTIRE PARISH is invited. High school classes are encouraged to attend. A sign up sheet will be available to go to the Georgetown Rd Planned Parenthood to pray sometime during the 40 days.

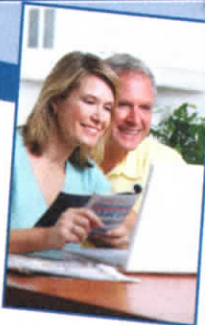
