EXTRAORDINARY MISSIONARY MONTH OCTOBER 2019

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

Pope Francis declared October 2019 as Extraordinary Missionary Month, being the 100th anniversary of the first missionary encyclical by Pope Benedict XV *Maximum illud* in 1919. October is the month of several missionary saints, beginning with St. Therese of the Child Jesus (Little Flower); October is the month of the Holy Rosary; October 20th is World Mission Sunday. Pope Francis will canonize four more new missionary saints on October 13th.

There are four things we could do:

1. Encounter Jesus in the Word and Eucharist.
2. Missionary teachings of saints and others could be read and meditated on.
3. Missionary formation: biblical, catechetical, spiritual and theological.
4. Missionary Charity.

This month's rosary could be dedicated to the intention of the world mission and for all continents and peoples. We could study all the missionary documents of the Church.

1. *Maximum illud* (Benedict XV) 1919
2. *Rerum Ecclesiae* (Pius XI) 1926
3. *Evangelii Praecones* (Pius XII) 1951
4. *Ad Gentes* (Vatican II) 1965
5. *Evangelii Nuntiandi* (Paul VI) 1975
6. *Redemptoris Missio* (John Paul II) 1990
7. *Evangelii Gaudium* (Pope Francis) 2013

Every baptized person is called to be a missionary. Almost all the documents of the Church reiterate the missionary aspect of our Christian calling. "I am a mission on this earth; that is the reason why I am here in this world." (*Christus Vivit*, 254). Let us take to heart this invitation of the Church to dedicate this month to keeping the missionary vocation the number one priority.

May God in His goodness and mercy fill the whole world with His love and may everyone come to the knowledge of truth in Christ Jesus.

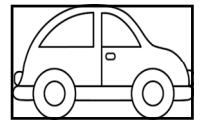

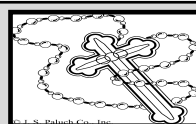
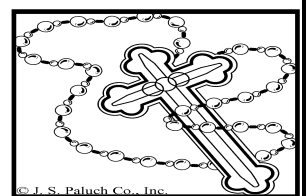
