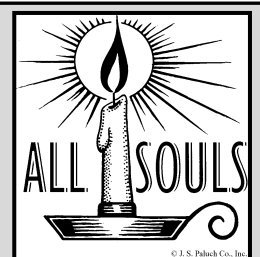
Mission Sunday/October 20

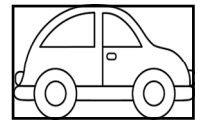

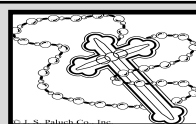
