Parish Mission Statement

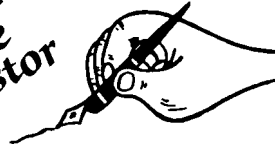

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2019 WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

This Sunday is World Mission Sunday. This year's observance of World Mission Sunday assumes even more importance in conjunction with Pope Francis' declaration of this month as an extraordinary missionary month. It was Pope Pius XI who instituted Mission Sunday for the whole Church in Oct 1927. This day is observed/celebrated in all local churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so Christians all over the world will recognize their Call to evangelize the whole world. Pope Francis in his message for the missionary month said: "Baptized and sent: The Church of Christ on mission in the world". Celebration of Mission Sunday, each year, will help us refocus on our Christian calling, the missionary dimension of our faith. When we look at the lives of the early apostles and missionaries, after their encounter with the Risen Lord, they couldn't but Proclaim. Such was the power of their encounter with Christ, the power of the Good News. The indelible mark of Christ the Risen Lord is etched deep within us at our Baptism and this union is strengthened at the subsequent reception of other sacraments. This is power; power to proclaim, power to be missionaries. Pope Francis says : "Each of us is a mission to the world, for each of us is the fruit of God's love". According to Vatican sources we have an estimated 1.2 billion Catholics spread across the globe and they form 50% of all the Christians in the world, and that makes it about 16% of the world population. The good news is that these 16% are spread out to all continents. And the total Christian population forms nearly 32% of the world population. If each of the Baptized evangelizes at least one person a year we would evangelize the whole world in a little over three years. The ball is in our court. The challenge is ours. Let us make a resolution to live the Call to be missionaries! Let us support our Mission Sunday through prayer, life, and financial giving.
