Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

We have had a very busy week with All Saints' Day, All Souls' Day and now the weekend liturgy. All Saints' Day is observed in the Catholic Church to remember all those who have entered heaven, including saints who are recognized by the Church and those who are not. All Saints' day was formally started by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Pantheon at Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the martyrs on May 13, 609 AD. He also established All Souls' Day which follows All Saints' Day to remember all the deceased. The choice of the day may have been included to co-opt the pagan the holiday "Feast of the Lamures", a day on which pagans used to placate the restless spirits of the dead. The Holy Day was eventually moved to November 1 by Pope Gregory III in the mid-eighth century as a day dedicated to the saints and their relics. Though the Protestants dismissed the need to pray for the dead, they retained the holy day to remember those who died recently, especially in the past year, and to remember the examples of those who lived holy lives. All Souls' Day is observed in different ways across the globe. I remember the days as a young boy going with my family members visiting the graves of those near and dear ones to offer flowers, light candles and pray for all the deceased members of our family after the Mass offered for all the departed brethren.

It's really important to pray for our deceased brothers and sisters because the deceased cannot help themselves. But the prayers of those living and the intercession of saints help them to get to heaven from the state of purification, because nothing unholy can enter heaven. The best form of prayer that one can offer is the Holy Mass. The tradition of remembering the Dead and praying for the deceased is really emphasized in Eastern Catholic Churches. The sacrifices and prayers offered for the deceased can go a long way in assisting the poor souls to the state of purification. May the Lord grant us the grace to remember the deceased and pray and make sacrifices for them.

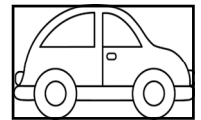

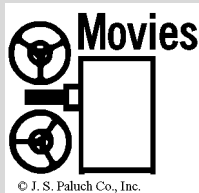
