My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are on Thanksgiving weekend. What a great day for us to be Thankful to God for everyone and everything we are blessed with. I wish to take this opportunity to Thank You All for your 'faith life' manifested through your life and commitment to the Church in terms of time, talent and treasure. I am so blessed to be among two wonderful faith communities, St. Ann and St. Thomas More. Thank you for your sacrifices, generosity and love for the Church. It's also an occasion to Thank God and one another as a family. Thanksgiving Day is probably marked by great family gatherings.

In 1863 Abraham Lincoln proclaimed that November 26 would be a national day to ask God to bless the families who had lost loved ones in the Civil War.-as well as to give thanks for the Union Army win at Gettysburg. He declared that a national day of Thanksgiving be observed on the last Thursday of November every year thereafter. Rite of Acceptance and Welcoming

On Sunday December 1st, we will celebrate a special Rite called the Rite of Acceptance during the 9:30 Mass at St. Ann and the 11:15 Mass at St. Thomas More. This is the first in a series of Rites in the RCIA process. In the Rite, the Church community will acknowledge, welcome and officially pray for those preparing to become fully Catholic at Easter (when they receive the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation). Through the Rite the unbaptized will transition from being inquirers about our faith to catechumens, who are becoming disciples of our faith. Also, concurrently, those in the RCIA process who have already been baptized but not fully Catholic (needing the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation) will spiritually move from inquirers and now be called candidates (as opposed to catechumens) and will similarly celebrate the Rite under the name Rite of Welcoming. Please share your Christian love, faith example and intercessory prayers with these people as they celebrate this milestone with us on their path toward Jesus.

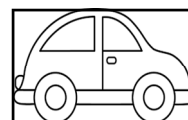

STM Pantry and Changes at Churches in Mission

Our St. Vincent de Paul committee has made changes to our pantry. We are now offering only hygiene products and cleaning products. This change has come about due to the changes at Churches in Mission (CIM). Churches in Mission has changed its food assistance policy making food assistance available once a week to their clients. Many times CIM runs low on cleaning supplies and hygiene items. We donated our food items to CIM and will now focus our pantry on hygiene and cleaning items. This will allow us to use more of our monies to meet the needs of our clients rather than spend monies on pantry food items that are not in demand due to local changes.

Also an update on other donations to St. Vincent de Paul or CIM. **Our committee DOES NOT accept clothing or household items.** There is a donation box in the parking lot at **St. Ann's** should you wish to donate items that are not accepted by Churches in Mission. You are also able to take your donation to SVdP downtown. There is no pickup for SVdP in this area. Presently Churches in Mission is only accepting new and gently used clothing of business and business casual wear and will only accept such donations on Mondays from 9-12 and Thursdays from 6-8. Items left outside their building will be disposed of due to contamination by weather and pest.

Jan Russell-Musters continues to collect clothing items for her outreach to the prison. Clothing for the **men** must meet strict guidelines. They need jeans and casual pants...no dress pants; plain sweaters; plain sweatshirts; jackets and/or coats (no dress coats or suits); polo shirts; t-shirts short or long sleeved; new underwear and socks; shoes - athletic or casual not dress; no belts or suspenders of any kind. **THERE CAN BE NO LOGOS OF SPORTS OR COMPANY NAMES ON ANY OF THE CLOTHING.** The prison is thankful for STM donations. Please leave these in the gym for Jan.

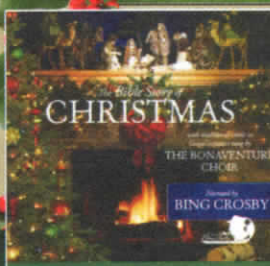

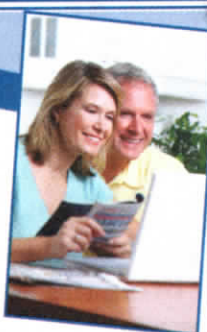
