Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christ the Light who was promised, as prophesied by the prophets, is to lead people who walked in darkness to light, from the land of gloom to abundant joy and rejoicing as He carried our burdens of sin (Is 9:3ff). Paul warns the people of Corinth of the danger of a divided community. One of the ways Satan attacks the Church today is by confusing the minds of people, just like the community of Corinth. Based on who baptized them they were claiming to be followers of Paul, Apollos, or Cephas. But Paul reminded the community that each of them should be solely a follower of Jesus Christ. Their faith is in Christ Jesus and not in individuals or God's servants who were instrumental in baptizing them. And Jesus continues His mission through the apostles who were called, set apart and sent forth to the mission. All the pastors and ministers of the word and sacraments are sent to God's vineyard, in different parishes, to continue Jesus' mission here on earth until His second coming. If God has given us a parish where you see the ministers get changed from time to time, our faith journey continues under different leadership. If our faith is in Christ Jesus, we shall not be moved or be shaken when there is a change of leadership in the Church. How often we have heard people say: "I like this Bishop, this priest". We have also heard people say, 'I do not like this priest' or 'this bishop' therefore I will try another church.

At a shopping center I met a person whom I know was a parishioner and I inquired how he was doing in life. I also inquired where he was going to church these days. It was quite shocking to me to hear; "Father, I go to another church where I feel nice. The chairs are comfortable and when I sit in church I feel like I am in a cinema theater". Today, I fear the danger of making our church-going feel nice. But, we need to be honest with our 'soul'. Did I get closer to Christ and His salvation?

Let us center our lives on Christ and grow in His love.

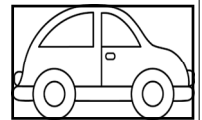

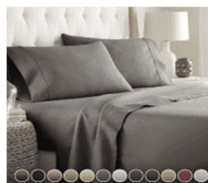

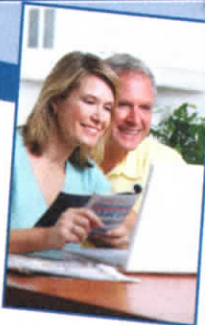
