**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

**The readings this weekend tell us the story of John the Baptist as one who reveals the true identity of Jesus as the ‘Lamb of God’. The Lamb of God for the Jews was significant; the one who takes away their sins and led them to the desert never to come back. Each year on the feast of Yom Kippur-The Day of Atonement, the whole community places their sins upon this lamb and it is sent to the desert-never to come back-meaning that the Lamb takes away their sins.
