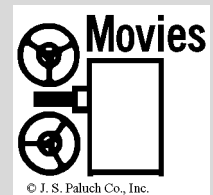

**SVDP QUARTERLY REPORT**

In an effort to show how your donations help, the St. Ann's SVdP Chapter would like to report the following results for the period of October 1 through December 31, 2019.

- 48 families (82 adults, 101 children) were helped in some way during this quarter
- 37 home visits made by our team members
- 51 bags of food were given to clients during home visits
- 32 referral slips were issued so clients could go to the SVdP Store (Mission 27) to get free merchandise (e.g., clothing, furniture, household items, and appliances)
- 7 families received some sort of financial assistance
- 17 food baskets were distributed at Christmas time

The blue collection box in the parking lot was emptied numerous times.

We are thankful to be stewards for such a caring and generous parish. We hope you will continue to support SVdP in 2020.
