March 1, 2020 1st Sunday of Lent

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Paul, in Ephesians 6:12ff, says: "For our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to withstand on that evil day and having everything to stand firm."

We are at war against the evil one. To fight against the evil one, Jesus gives us three weapons: Prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Lent is a time we intensify this war against the forces of evil that exist in us as individuals, in our families and our communities.

We begin a decisive battle on Ash Wednesday for the coming forty days. The Ashes that we put on were once palm branches, which waved gloriously on Palm Sunday, solemnly receiving the Lord into Jerusalem singing Hosanna. And now they are a symbol, repeating our continuing unfaithfulness, and our steadfast intent to turn toward the cross and our baptism once again. The symbol of the cross made on our forehead with ashes reconnects us to death, the cross and the suffering of Jesus and invites us to acknowledge our sins and make reparations and to a radical conversion to the Lord and His Kingdom.

Yahweh's invitation through Prophet Joel marks the epicenter of the season of Lent. "Return to the Lord with all your heart" (Joel 2:12). For Joel, conversion is a turning back. Those who have chosen the paths of sin are invited to come back to the original grace and love the Lord put within you.

Throughout the season of Lent the word of God mentions the word 'prize' reserved for the righteous and 'punishment' for the wicked. The reward Jesus refers to is the increased capacity to love, the most intimate union, the sharpest resemblance to the face of the Father. It's the joy to love gratuitously as God does, the very character of the Kingdom of God.

To grow in love, Jesus proposes three ascetic practices: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. Prayer is discreetly listening with an open heart and mind to discern God's plan for us. Prayer teaches us to abandon idolatry and the self sufficiency of our ego and to acknowledge our need for the Lord and His mercy.

Fasting is learning to change our attitude towards others and all of creation, turning away from the temptation to 'devour' everything, to be ready to suffer for love. The acceptable fast will break the fetters of injustice...fast by sharing your bread with the hungry, bring to your house the homeless, clothe the one you see naked. (IS 58:6-7).

Almsgiving For Jesus, almsgiving is not just to drop a few coins, but to restore justice, to recognize that the goods of this world do not belong to man but to God. Almsgiving shows us the path to move from the insecurity of hoarding everything for ourselves, to rediscover the joy of God's plan for creation and for each one of us.

On the first day of Lent we are reminded that Lent begins with ashes and ends with the Holy Fire, the paschal fire of the Risen Lord and the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Christ has poured His blood on our existence which is dust and glorified it through His Resurrection.

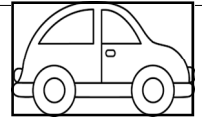

**31 CLUB**

In last weekend's bulletin, there was an announcement for a new vocations-related ministry – it's called the 31 Club. It's a new option to offer prayer for vocations. The 31 Club will supplement the two other existing vocations prayer ministries we already have at STM: the weekly Vocations Cross and the Monday Rosary for Vocations during Adoration. Our hope is that at least one of these ministries will appeal to our parishioners as a way to pray for vocations.

This is how the 31 Club works:

Each member of the 31 Club chooses one day of the month (thus the name - 31 potential days to choose from!) to attend Mass on that day and offer it for priestly and religious vocations. If you are not able to attend your chosen date, the nearest convenient date is fine. You may attend Mass anywhere, but your intentions at that Mass should be for the priests, deacons, and religious of St. Thomas More and St. Ann, and for vocations to be called from our parish family. You offer this Mass:

- For priests and religious who have served us in the past;
- For those serving now; That the Lord will call future vocations from our parish family. That's all there is to it! You simply pledge to devote one hour a month – attending a Mass – on the same date each month to praying for vocations. Maybe you already attend daily Mass at STM/St. Ann or elsewhere, or maybe this might be a gentle nudge to find time to attend weekday Mass a bit more often – whatever your situation, this is an easy way to devote prayer for vocations. If you are interested in signing up for a date, we will have a poster-sized calendar available in the social hall beginning next weekend, with the club starting in March.

Again, the 31 Club is not replacing the Vocations Cross or the Monday Rosary in Adoration – it's simply just another option we wanted to provide. Thank you so much for your participation in our vocations ministry!

Please let me know if you have any questions. May God raise up new seminarians, priests, deacons, and religious.
