Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Moses was truly a mediator and leader of God's people and he stood the test of time, especially during their journey to the promised land. It was not an easy journey-not for the people much less for Moses. Moses heard the grumbings of his people throughout their journey in the desert. The people of Israel were grumbling over what they didn't have in the desert, forgetting the fact that they had been slaves in a foreign land. Their focus was in their past and not the future, and so they had many reasons to grumble against their leader. God gave several signs through Moses of their need to refocus on their future-the promised land.

I truly understand the inconveniences due to the changes made during the celebration of the Sacrament of the Eucharist. I share your pains and concerns, but at the same time, please understand that we need to be considerate towards others. The precautionary measures we take will benefit others who are more vulnerable than us because of their age or other health related issues. We are advised to receive Holy Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue at least for some time from now until further notification. For those who are allergic to Gluten, we have made arrangements for gluten free hosts. Please let me/Maureen or the office know which Mass you plan to attend to help us prepare ahead of time. Above all, please invoke the Lord's protection upon you and your family and the entire human family. Stay calm but be vigilant and be prudent to avoid as many travels and gatherings as possible. Think of the harm that we can do to others if we get infected rather than our own little inconveniences we undergo in order to help our brothers and sisters. If you are ill, please stay home-you are exempt from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. However, you are not exempt from obligation if you're staying away from Sunday Mass simply out of fear of catching something.

31 CLUB

This is how the 31 Club works:

Each member of the 31 Club chooses one day of the month (thus the name - 31 potential days to choose from!) to attend Mass on that day and offer it for priestly and religious vocations. If you are not able to attend your chosen date, the nearest convenient date is fine. You may attend Mass anywhere, but your intentions at that Mass should be for the priests, deacons, and religious of St. Thomas More and St. Ann, and for vocations to be called from our parish family. You offer this Mass:

- For priests and religious who have served us in the past;
- For those serving now; That the Lord will call future vocations from our parish family. That's all there is to it! You simply pledge to devote one hour a month – attending a Mass – on the same date each month to praying for vocations. Maybe you already attend daily Mass at STM/St. Ann or elsewhere, or maybe this might be a gentle nudge to find time to attend weekday Mass a bit more often – whatever your situation, this is an easy way to devote prayer for vocations. Again, the 31 Club is not replacing the Vocations Cross or the Monday Rosary in Adoration – it's simply just another option we wanted to provide. Thank you so much for your participation in our vocations ministry!

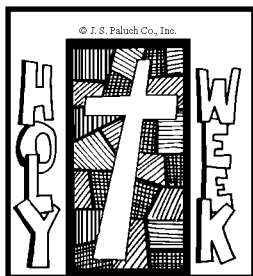
