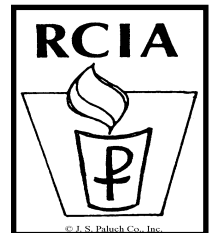

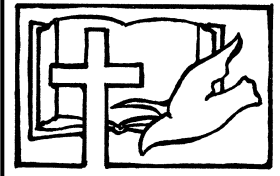

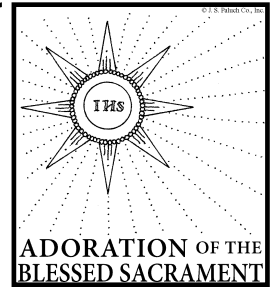
VOCATIONS CROSS PRAYER MINISTRY

STUFF A TRUCK WITH GOOD STUFF FOR GOOD PURPOSE

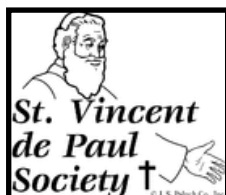

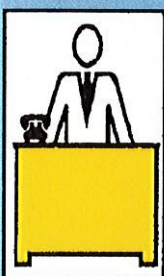
