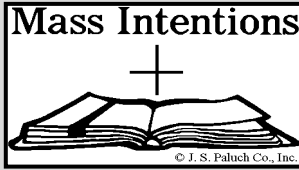
God calls each one of us to surrender to God's will. May He help us to accept and follow His will in our lives.
