**Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,**

**The stone that the builders rejected has become The cornerstone.  
(Mt 21:42).**

**All of us humans need recognition, acceptance and love from others. The core of our feeling unloved and rejected comes from the fact that we tend to forget that ‘we are loved’ because God who is Love itself is dwelling within us. We hear of increased numbers of suicides during this pandemic. People who found love, acceptance and recognition outside of themselves through relationships with others (friends and families) experienced a terrible time of separation during the lockdown period. It is worse when someone we love deeply rejects us. Rejection is perhaps the most painful experience in one’s life; yet even the experience of rejection can be made full of grace and beneficial. Of all rejections that have been experienced throughout the ages, there is one that stands out above the rest; it’s the rejection of the Son of God. Jesus had only pure and perfect love in His Heart. The wound He experienced in His Heart from the rejection of so many was His greatest pain and caused much suffering. Suffering in this sense was an act of love, not an act of weakness. His love was rejected. When that Holy love was rejected, it filled Him with holy sorrow, spoken of in the beatitudes. (Blessed are those who mourn) (Mt 5:6). This sorrow was not a form of despair; rather, it was a deep experience of the loss of the love of another. It was holy, and a result of His burning love for all.**

**Jesus leaves us a great example of how to respond to rejection-to transform the rejection experience into a cornerstone building experience. Jesus knew and was always aware of the inseparable union and the love of the Heavenly Father and the Holy Spirit so nothing would really shake Him. This is the truth that you and I tend to forget when experiencing human rejection. Each of us needs to transform those moments of rejection into moments of grace, which would be possible by close union with the Most Holy Trinity dwelling within us. Life is worth living just because He loves us.**

**I would like to thank all the volunteers who, week after week, have been helping at our drive-through dinners at St. Ann’s.**

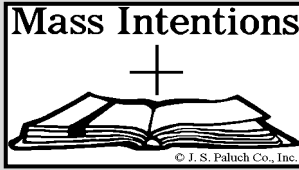

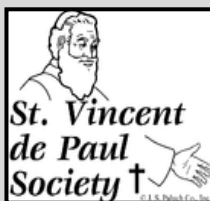
Although we are not able to have the event as we originally envisioned, we're pleased to announce that we will be able to offer the silent auction component as usual. We have many exciting items to offer this year.

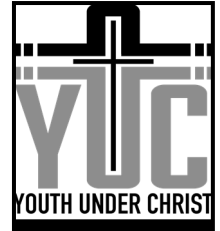
