October 11, 2020 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The month of October is observed as the month of the Holy Rosary. We celebrated the feast of the Holy Rosary October 7.

It was Pope St. Pius V who established this feast in 1573. The purpose was to thank God for the victory of the Christians over the Turks at Lepanto-a victory attributed to the praying of the Rosary. Pope Clement XI extended the feast to the universal Church in 1716. Today's feast was formerly known as Our Lady of Victory and the feast of the Holy Rosary. The Church celebrates the feast on the anniversary of the decisive victory of the combined fleet of the Holy League of 1571 over the Ottoman navy at the Battle of Lepanto.

The development of the rosary has a long history. First there was a practice of praying 150 Our Father's in imitation of the 150 psalms. Then there was a parallel practice of praying 150 Hail Mary's. Soon a mystery of Jesus' life was attached to each Hail Mary. Though Mary's giving of the rosary to St. Dominic is recognized as a legend, the development of this prayer owes much to the followers of St. Dominic. One of them, Alan de la Roche, was known as "the Apostle of the Rosary." He founded the first fraternity of the Rosary in the 15th century. In the 16th century, the rosary was developed to its present form-with the 15 mysteries, Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious. In 2002 Pope St. John Paul II added the 5 mysteries of Light.

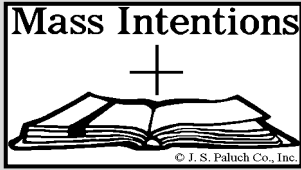
The purpose of the Rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. Pope Pius XII called it a compendium of the Gospel. The main focus is on Jesus, his birth, life, death and Resurrection. The Our Father's remind us that the father is the initiator of salvation. The Hail Mary's remind us to join with Mary in contemplating these mysteries. The Glory Be's remind us that the purpose of all life is the glory of the Trinity.

I wish and pray that we make praying the Rosary a part of our daily family prayer. May our Blessed Mother Mary intercede for us and strengthen our family life. Vocations to the priesthood and religious life will come from families that pray and have a great devotion to Blessed Mother Mary. Mary can work wonders in your life.

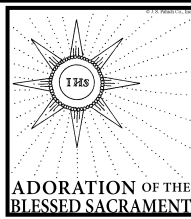

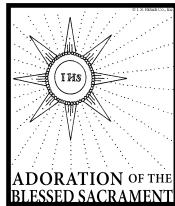

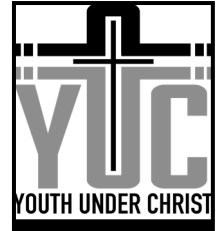

St. Vincent de Paul Announces Virtual Struttin' Our Stuff Event

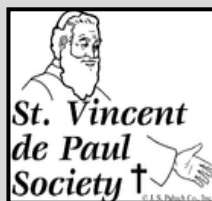
Although we are not able to have the event as we originally envisioned, we're pleased to announce that we will be able to offer the silent auction component as usual. We have many exciting items to offer this year.
