**Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,**

**This weekend's reading reminds us of the special care and protection the Lord provides to the less fortunate and most vulnerable ones of our society: "you shall not molest or oppress an alien, for you were once aliens yourselves in the land of Egypt. You shall not wrong any widow or orphan. If ever you wrong them and they cry out to me, I will surely hear their cry. My wrath will flare up, and I will kill you with the sword; then your own wives will be widows, and your children orphans." (Ex 22:20-23).**

**A good measure of our moral character is found in how we treat a stranger or alien. People often find it easy to treat their own flesh and blood well, but God commands us to have concern for others, including the stranger.**

**The hatred and strife between ethnic groups and national groups show just how little humanity has progressed. If we stay with our own safe group and enjoy all the blessings but fail to be reaching out and looking out as blessings to others, we mistreat a stranger. The widows and fatherless children were the weakest and most vulnerable members of society. In an unrestrained, survival-of-the-fittest society, they would be the first to suffer abuse and destruction.**

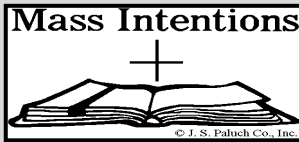

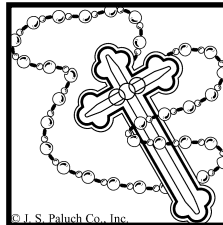

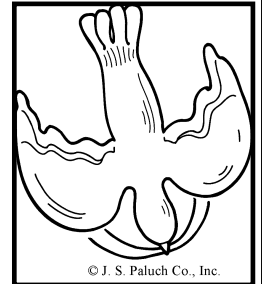
