### February 14, 2014 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,** 

We are preparing to enter into the holy season of Lent with Ash Wednesday falling on the 17th of this month. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. It is the start of 40 days of prayer, penance and almsgiving as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ on Easter. Ash Wednesday was added to the liturgical calendar well after the 40-day penitential season of Lent became the norm throughout the Latin Church. Lent, in turn, was universally established only after the early Church sorted out the date of Easter. The issue was clarified at the Council of Nicea 325 where "all the churches agree that Easter, the Christian Passover, should be celebrated on the Sunday following the first full moon (14 Nissan) after the vernal equinox" (CCC 1170). The vernal equinox normally falls on March 21, thus the dark of Easter in the Western Church can occur anytime between March 22 and April 25. This year Easter falls on April 4th.

What does Ash signify? When God drove out the first parents from the Garden, he reminded Adam, "You are dust, and unto dust you shall return" (Gen. 3:19). We hear these words pronounced by the priest as he places the ash on our forehead. It's a reminder of our mortality and the seriousness of the Lenten pilgrimage we are about to begin. Throughout the OT ashes signify sorrow and repentance; the prophets used the expression "dress in sack cloth and ashes" meaning sorrow and repentance.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are two obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence are binding from age 14 onwards.

I urge you, my brothers and sisters, to enter into this season with prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We also ask the intercession of St. Joseph as we prepare to do the 33 days of Consecration to St. Joseph.

May Blessed Mother, who walked with her son to Calvary, give us a deeper understanding of the mysteries of the Lord's passion, death and resurrection.

Please give consideration to serving on the St. Ann Pastoral Council. You could be a part of needed parish reconstruction in the wake of the Covid 19 pandemic.






