**March 21, 2021 5th Sunday of Lent**

**Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,**

**We are almost on the last leg of the Lenten journey. We have a reading from the Gospel of John, Chapter 12, which is a preparation for the beginning of the passion narrative to follow. Jesus has just raised Lazarus from the dead—an important sign in the Gospel of John, inspiring many people to believe in Jesus. This event also marks the turning point in Jesus' conflict with the Jewish authorities. The Gospel tells us that the Sanhedrin met after this event and made plans to kill Jesus. In the 12th chapter of John's Gospel, Jesus is anointed at Bethany and enters Jerusalem in triumph. Following his triumphant entry into Jerusalem, Jesus predicts his suffering, death and resurrection and prepares his disciples to believe in the salvation his death would accomplish. All these events lead us to the Holy Week or Great Week where the mysteries of God's love and salvation are most powerfully manifested in Christ's passion, death and resurrection.**

**As we embark upon the paschal events of the mystery of salvation, let us allow the Spirit of God to sweep over us and lead us to the depths of the mystery of the divine love. God's love is celebrated through the sacraments, especially through the sacrament of Reconciliation. We are given the opportunity as a faith community to go through the sacrament of Reconciliation and prepare ourselves to celebrate the paschal mystery.**

**Let us enter into Holy Week with hearts and minds washed in the blood of the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ.**

This year we have some new guidelines and criteria on garage sale items to be donated. We will be following the guidelines from St. Vincent de Paul and Goodwill.

1. No mattresses
2. No computer items, monitor, keyboards, wires, etc.
3. No broken items
4. No items missing a lid, handle, cord, etc.
5. No electrical items that are missing parts, or a frayed cord, or the item is not working as it should. This applies to tools, small kitchen appliances, yard items, lamps, radios, etc.
6. No pianos, organs, large musical instruments
7. Furniture should be clean and in good repair
8. Please donate items that are clean, (we have spent a lot of time washing dishes, glasses, clothing, dressers, pillows, etc.)
9. Any donated item that is not clean, broken, or we know will not sell we will place it in the dumpster

SVdP will only take nice, clean, working items (no clothing).

Items may be dropped off from May 10 through May 29. Sale starts on Thursday, June 3, 2021. We like to have time to prepare the space (gym, barn, and possible K of C shelter) and to organize the items. It is a big job, and we appreciate all the donations and workers. Set up will begin on Monday, May 24, 2021

Keep in mind that after the sale is over, we must have help loading items in volunteer's trucks/vehicles to transport items to SVdP, Goodwill, Habitat, etc.
