March 28, 2021 Holy Week

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

And here we are in Holy Week. We thank God that we are able to celebrate Holy Week in person this year. We missed celebrating in person as a community last year. We are asked by the Holy See to carefully plan our community celebrations with all the safety measures in place.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, with the commemoration of the Lord's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. It also has the passion readings in the Church, reminding us of the entrance of Jesus into his passion.

Holy Thursday reminds us of the celebration of the Lord's Supper; the first Eucharist was offered before the Apostles by Jesus. He instituted the New Testament ministerial priesthood and the Eucharist.

Good Friday is a day we commemorate the Lord's passion, crucifixion and death. It is a day of fast and abstinence. We have the Lord's Passion celebration at 3:00 pm, the hour that commemorates his death. At 2:00 pm we gather outside the Church (weather permitting) for the Stations of the Cross.

Easter Vigil-This year the Easter Vigil will be celebrated at St. Ann's Church and the celebration of the Easter sacraments will take place at St. Ann. This will be celebrated alternately, year after year, as long as the linked status of St. Thomas More and St. Ann churches are in place. By this practice both churches will have the opportunity to witness the celebration of the Easter Vigil and Easter sacraments.

Through the celebration of the Easter mysteries we are called to die with Christ for our sins and rise with Him to eternal life. May this season be a season of abundant graces through the merits of Christ's passion, suffering, death and resurrection.

I would like to thank all our wonderful catechists, led by Deacon Joe and Marianne, who prepared the candidates and catechumens for the celebration of the Easter sacraments. Thanks to all the catechists: Janet Musters, Mary Bohney, Paul Gall, Philip Fowler, Jackie & Mike Cesnik. A special thanks to our Liturgical coordinators Maureen Shea & Donna McGrath, and to Mike, Maureen and their teams for the beautiful music. Thank you all.

May the Joy and Peace of the Risen Lord be with you all. Happy Easter!

I also want to invite you to the Divine Mercy Sunday Celebration April 11 at 2:30 pm at St. Ann's. There will be opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday.

This year we have some new guidelines and criteria on garage sale items to be donated. We will be following the guidelines from St. Vincent de Paul and Goodwill.

- 1. No mattresses**
- 2. No computer items, monitor, keyboards, wires, etc.**
- 3. No broken items**
- 4. No items missing a lid, handle, cord, etc.**
- 5. No electrical items that are missing parts, or a frayed cord, or the item is not working as it should. This applies to tools, small kitchen appliances, yard items, lamps, radios, etc.**
- 6. No pianos, organs, large musical instruments**
- 7. Furniture should be clean and in good repair**
- 8. Please donate items that are clean, (we have spent a lot of time washing dishes, glasses, clothing, dressers, pillows, etc.)**
- 9. Any donated item that is not clean, broken, or we know will not sell we will place it in the dumpster**

SVdP will only take nice, clean, working items (no clothing).

Items may be dropped off from May 10 through May 29. Sale starts on Thursday, June 3, 2021. We like to have time to prepare the space (gym, barn, and possible K of C shelter) and to organize the items. It is a big job, and we appreciate all the donations and workers.

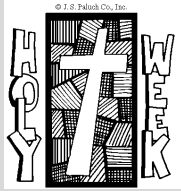
