**April 11, 2021 Divine Mercy Sunday**

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

**Divine Mercy Sunday is a very special Sunday when the Divine flood-gates from Heaven are opened wide and Jesus offers us the total forgiveness of all sins and punishments to any soul who goes to confession and receives Him in Holy Communion on that day. This devotion was started based on a particular revelation to a Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, by Our Lord from 1931-1938.**

**On the second Sunday of Easter of the Jubilee year 2000, at the Mass for the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, Pope John Paul II declared that the Sunday after Easter be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday'. St. Faustina wrote in her diary that the Lord said: "I want the image (of the Divine Mercy) to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it... My daughter, tell the whole world about my inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy." According to the vision, those who receive communion and go to confession on that feast of mercy receive total forgiveness of sins.**

**This feast is very special to all of us. It's a day to refresh ourselves by allowing God's mercy to cover us and release us from every sin and punishment. The Church also grants a plenary indulgence for all who participate in the Divine Mercy Sunday Celebration and fulfill the general conditions of plenary indulgences (praying a creed, praying for the Holy Father, receiving communion and being in a state of complete grace.)**

**Our celebration of Divine Mercy starts at 2:30 pm at St. Ann's Church. I request you all to please consider attending and going to confession and communion. Jesus, I trust in you! Have mercy on us and on the whole world.**

**I will be remembering you all in my prayers, especially at the altar.**

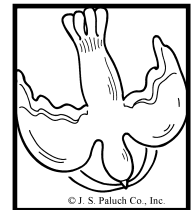

**This year we have some new guidelines and criteria on garage sale items to be donated. We will be following the guidelines from St. Vincent de Paul and Goodwill.**

- 1. No mattresses**
- 2. No computer items, monitor, keyboards, wires, etc.**
- 3. No broken items**
- 4. No items missing a lid, handle, cord, etc.**
- 5. No electrical items that are missing parts, or a frayed cord, or the item is not working as it should. This applies to tools, small kitchen appliances, yard items, lamps, radios, etc.**
- 6. No pianos, organs, large musical instruments**
- 7. Furniture should be clean and in good repair**
- 8. Please donate items that are clean, (we have spent a lot of time washing dishes, glasses, clothing, dressers, pillows, etc.)**
- 9. Any donated item that is not clean, broken, or we know will not sell we will place it in the dumpster**

**SVdP will only take nice, clean, working items (no clothing).**

**Items may be dropped off from May 10 through May 29. Sale starts on Thursday, June 3, 2021. We like to have time to prepare the space (gym, barn, and possible K of C shelter) and to organize the items. It is a big job, and we appreciate all the donations and workers.**

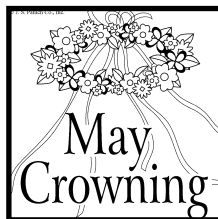
