
#### Parish Mission Statement

May 23, 2021 Pentecost Sunday

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,** 

This weekend the Church celebrates the Feast of Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year. Pentecost concludes the Easter season and marks the beginning of the Church. Pentecost always occurs 50 days after Easter and 10 days after Jesus's ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a movable feast without a fixed date, Pentecost is also a movable feast without a fixed date. Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13. We began the Novena for the Feast of Pentecost last Friday (9 days before). Traditionally the Church prays the Novena to the Holy Spirit in preparation, reminding us of Acts 1 where Mary and the Apostles stayed together in prayer in preparation, awaiting the "Power from Above". Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus. who were gathered together in prayer in the Upper Room. The "Power from Above" empowered the frightened apostles, who were behind closed doors, to become powerful, fearless witnesses for Christ. The Holy Spirit also gave the Apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission-to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be "clothed with power" before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel.

May this Pentecost be a time of renewal and a reminder of the call to witness Christ and become good news to all creation.

May Blessed Mother Mary and the saints intercede for us.




