May 30, 2012 Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here is an ancient song to the Trinity:

All hail, adored Trinity!

All hail, eternal Unity!

**O God the Father, God the Son,
and God the Spirit, ever One.**

In his letter to Timothy, St. Paul writes, “God dwells in inaccessible light.” The mystery of the mystical union between the three persons in One God is what we celebrate this weekend. Most priests probably don’t like to give their homily based on this joyful feast of the Most Holy Trinity. Even if we do not understand the mystical Union of the three persons, God is one and yet revealed himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and He lives in us from the day of our Baptism. This is a reality that you and I experience within and yet words cannot explain adequately or at least no one has succeeded in doing this.

A little story is a way of approaching the mystery. A gypsy man stopped at a well in a town square for a drink. After he drank he continued gazing into the well as if he was looking down at someone at the bottom of the well. A little boy saw him, and though the man was big and tall and rough and ready, he had a kindly face, and so the little boy approached him. “Who lives down there?” the little boy asked. And the gypsy man answered him, “God lives down there.” And the little boy says, “Can I see him too?” “Of course you can,” said the gentle gypsy man . And he picks him up in his arms and he leans him over the well but all he could see was his own pale reflection in the water below. Disappointed, he turns to the gypsy man and says, “But all I can see is me!” “Ah”, says the gypsy man looking into his eyes. “Now you know where God lives.” And he picks the little boy up, puts him on the ground, and looks into his eyes and says, “God lives in you.”

We celebrate our life whenever we recognize the presence of God in us and in others. This calls us to respect and honor our neighbor. We are all God’s children and we belong to this family. Let us love one another as He has loved us.

I want to thank Andrew Murrey and the Parish Council and the Knights of Columbus for organizing last Sunday’s Barbecue and Rosary. I encourage everyone to pray the rosary in your families.

A small group of six went on a mini pilgrimage to the National Shrine of St. Joseph, De Pere, Wi. and to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help, Wi. I want you to know that we remembered you all and lit three candles: one each for St. Thomas More, St. Ann, and St. Pius, and prayed for you all. On our way back on Monday we went fishing in Lake Michigan. It was fun.

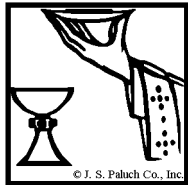

VOCATION MINISTRY

**The Vocations Ministry at St. Thomas
More has four main objectives.**

**1. To promote vocations awareness and
education in the parish. We communicate
the critical nature of the priest shortage
within the Archdiocese. We discuss voca-
tions in our Faith Formation classes and
encourage our high school boys to attend
open houses at Bishop Simon Brute Semi-
nary.**

**2. To pray for vocations. We coordinate
the Vocations Cross prayer ministry in
which parishioners take home a kit full of
resources about praying for vocations. We
have also had Holy Hours dedicated to vo-
cations and distribute prayer cards as dai-
ly prayer reminders for seminarians and
religious from the Archdiocese.**

**3. To support the needs of seminari-
ans. We have "adopted" a seminarian at
St. Meinrad, Anthony Armbruster, and
send him cards and notes of encourage-
ment. We have also hosted an annual din-
ner for seminarians from Bishop Simon
Brute Seminary, and we have also sent
them care packages.**

**4. To identify parishioners who could be
good candidates to the priesthood, diaco-
nate, or religious life. We encourage our
parishioners to talk to their children about
vocations and to be open to the idea that
God may be calling them to a religious vo-
cation.**

additional volunteers to help serve this
ministry. If you are interested, please con-

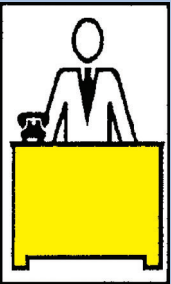
