June 6, 2021 Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me.” (John 6:54-57)

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Lord’s most precious gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on Thursday following Trinity Sunday or as in the USA on the Sunday after that feast. This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. At every Eucharistic celebration our attention is called to the Real Presence of Christ in it and the secondary focus is upon the Body of Christ, the presence of Christ in the Church. In normal situations we would have had a Eucharistic procession in and around the Church publicly proclaiming the real presence of Jesus.

As St. Paul says: “As often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until He comes. (1 Corinthians 11:26) Whenever we partake of this great mystery of Love, we proclaim the Lord’s passion, death and resurrection. This is the center of our faith in Christ. This is the greatest gift of Christ to all of us. However, this gift is to be received worthily with great care. To receive the Eucharist one needs to be in a state of grace—at the least, one has to be free from any mortal sin. The reception of the sacrament of Reconciliation allows us to be washed clean in the blood of Jesus and helps us grow in this union with Christ who comes to us in Holy Communion.

May this weekend be a time when we can all enter into a deeper understanding of the Eucharist and passionately love Jesus in the Eucharist. May the Lord in the Eucharist help us grow in love and in reverence to this most precious gift of the Lord.

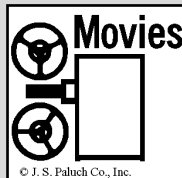

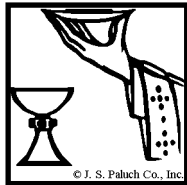

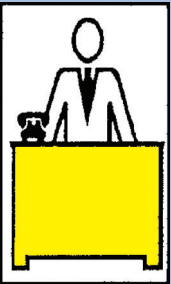
