Dear Family at St. Thomas More and St. Ann's,

As the saying goes: "It takes a village to raise a child." And, I have found that it also takes a village or two to run a parish.

I wish to express my heartfelt thanks to all my family at St. Thomas More and St. Ann. Without your support it would not be possible to create the vibrant parishes that you have become.

Further, I would like to thank all of the wonderful volunteers that work so tirelessly to maintain our grounds and facilities and who work on all of our events. And I would be remiss if I did not also thank all of our dedicated leadership and members of our Commissions, Committees, and Ministries. And then there is our parish staff who work so tirelessly to meet and often exceed my expectations in taking care of all the big things and the little things that make our parishes successful.

I am saddened by my need to move at this point in time. I would like to have lingered a while longer to see how much further we could journey together. But, as I have often said: "The Lord has a plan for each of his children." For me that is moving on to St. Pius X. For all of you, it means moving forward with Father Jude, who also was placed here by the Lord.

I want to also take the time to talk about a little unfinished business at St. Thomas More. Our Forward In Faith Capital Campaign was a resounding success; and we achieved all of our financial goals for the campaign. Unfortunately, due to the pandemic, our construction phase has been hampered by the virus, a shortage of labor and a shortage of building materials. We completed construction of our Rectory, the electrical upgrades to the barn, office renovation, and added hearing assistance in Church for the hard of hearing. The Projects for the Restroom Renovation, the ADA doors for the handicapped, and the Kitchen Renovation are in process and should be completed soon. We are still working on the final specifications for the Classrooms. But I want to assure you that we have the necessary funding to complete all of these projects. I have reviewed/discussed all of the projects with Father Jude and our building committee, and he plans to carry them forward to completion. A new, much more energy efficient boiler is being installed currently. We have also saved enough funds, which have been placed in the budget for 2021-2022 for repaving the entire parking lot. All these and more were possible because of each one of you.

As for St. Ann, our building loan from the Archdiocese has been brought under \$950,000.00. To reduce usage of power, the building committee has come up with a very good plan and I have approved it.

The role of a pastor is never easy, especially fulfilling the role of governance. In this process of governance, if I have offended anyone, I extend my apologies; please know that it was never personal. In the greater interest of the Church, I have made decisions that may not have been up to your expectation. My sincere apologies.

Thanks for all the memories; and God speed to one and all.

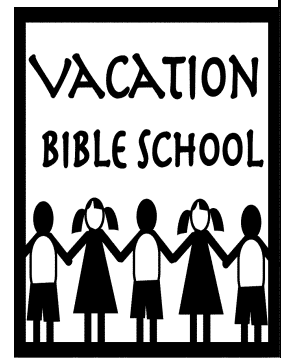

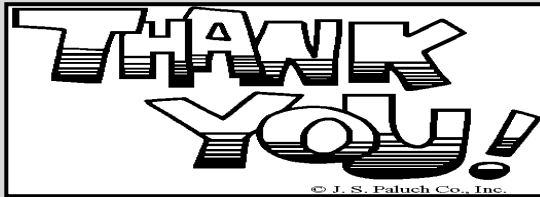

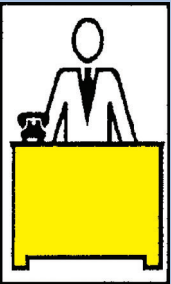
