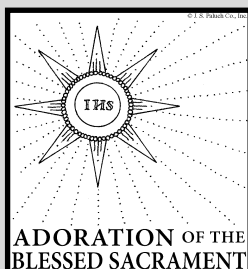

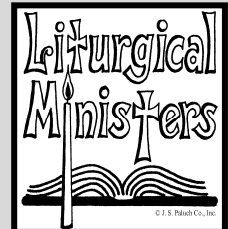

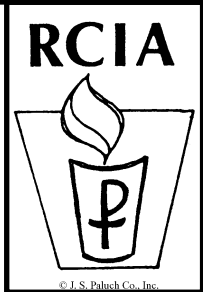

Middle School/High School Youth Group

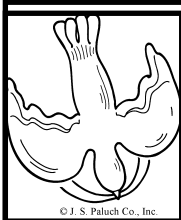
St. Thomas More is offering a high school led middle school youth group.

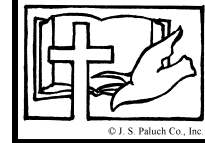

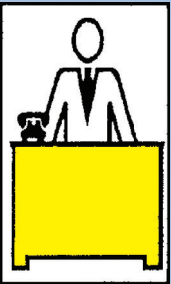
