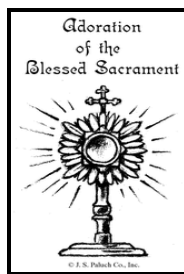

More History of STM Parish

My family moved to West County Line Road just a few years before St Thomas More came to be. At that time at the edge of our back yard was a large field with a farmhouse and a barn on it facing Indiana Street. When it was announced a Catholic church was being built in that field and practically in our back yard it was exciting. My parents, Joe & Lucille Minardo were charter members and very active in the building of the church and my brothers Joey & David were particularly fascinated in helping with the pipe organ. The building of the church also forged friendships with the families of the Warthens, Waldens, Ginders, O'Connor's, Neitzels, DuCharmes and many others. But my favorite memories are the many times Father Briggeman would cross that field from his trailer that had been set up as temporary housing at the time to our house. He was such an amazing person. Many good times and lively conversations were had at our home with Father B. He had a Volkswagen bus that he carted my brothers and others around in to make trips into town usually for supplies but more for fun. After the youth group was established if we were heading somewhere everyone wanted to ride in that Volkswagen bus!
