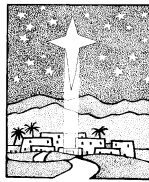

### Advent Bible Study

Join us this Advent as we take 3 weeks to prepare ourselves for the coming of Christ! Are we ready for the King? Are our hearts ready to receive our Savior? The four weeks leading up to Christmas mark the beginning of the Western Church's liturgical year. Advent is our time for reflection, meditation and preparation. This year the Sunday gospel readings at Mass come from the Gospel of Mark. Our engagement with this gospel, woven with other parts of Scripture, like Isaiah, 1 Corinthians, and 2 Samuel creates a beautiful tapestry of prepared anticipation for the Christ Child coming to the world and into our hearts. This study follows the Catholic Scripture Study format but concentrates on the Sunday lectionary readings and incorporates the ancient method of *Lectio Divina* (praying the scriptures to us personally through scripture).

Just write **Forward in Faith** on the face of the envelope; and, drop it in the collection basket. And, of course feel free to mail payments to the office if you so wish.*

*All **Forward in Faith** funds collected will be reported in the parish financial statements in addition to being published in the bulletin on a regular basis.*

*The Archdiocese requires that 50% of the funds be collected prior to construction. After the pledge data is compiled we will have a better idea as to how the projects will proceed. We will provide regular updates as information becomes available.*
