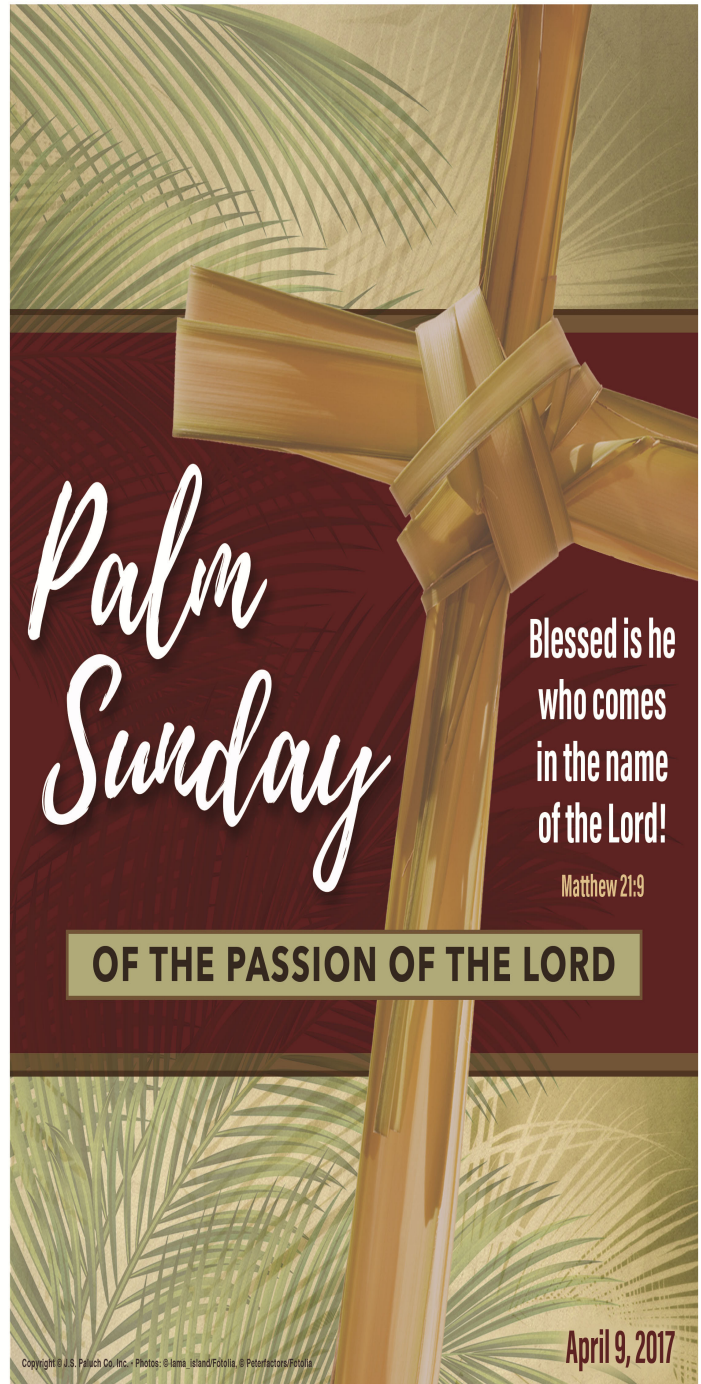

The solemn entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday masses marks the Holy Week or the Great Week. This is the most important week of the entire liturgical year. 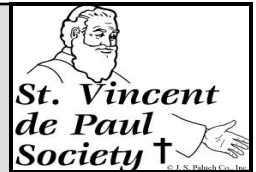
