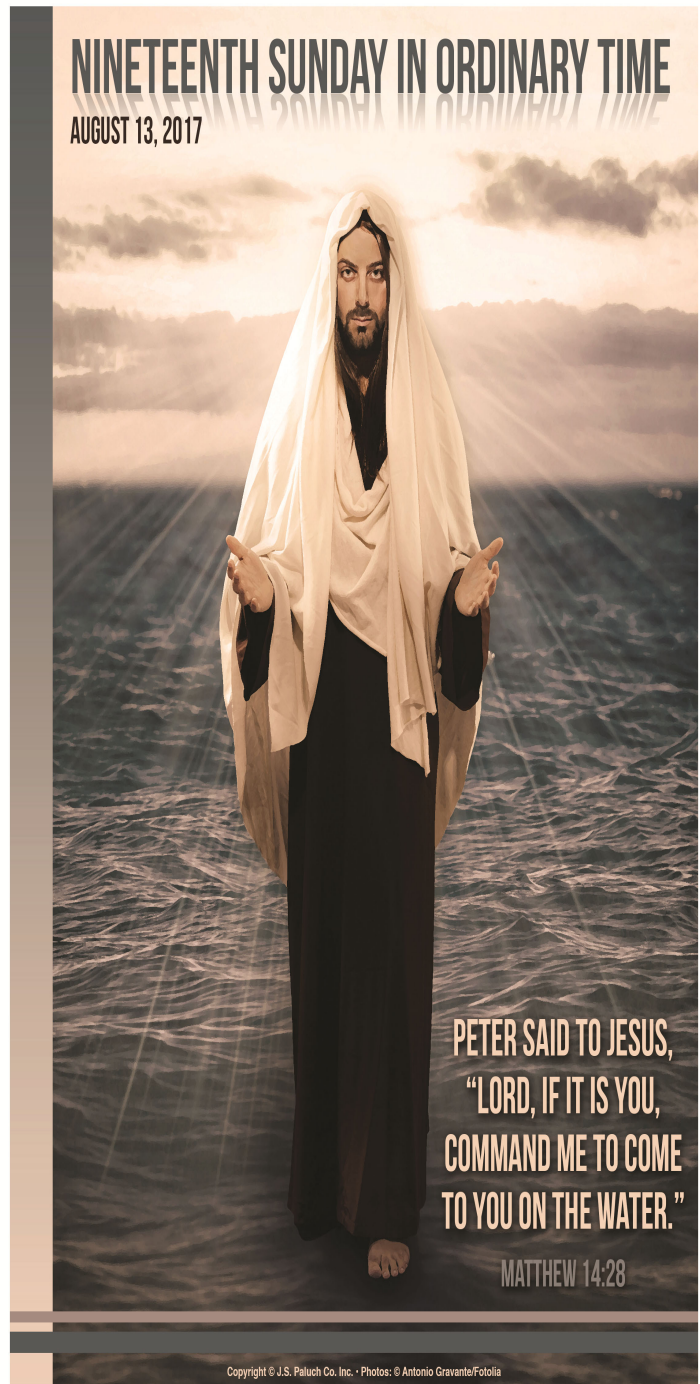

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Tired after hectic activities, the great prophet Elijah was brought to Mount Horeb. It was a time for Elijah to consider his call and his vocation. He was asked to stand on the mountain as the Lord was to pass by. He wasn't able to encounter Yahweh in the strong and heavy wind, nor in the earthquake, nor in the fire. But in the tiny whispering sound he encountered Yahweh and that was a life-changing experience for Elijah. God's glory shined through the face of Elijah. 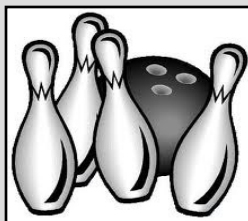

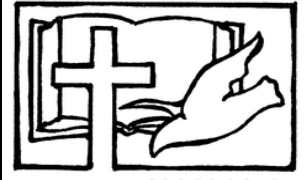
