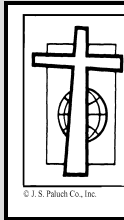

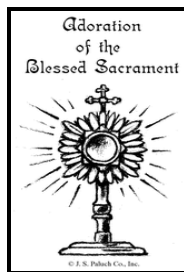

**More History of STM Parish**

Criterion Nov. 24, 1995: St. Thomas More keeps thriving and growing: Located in Mooresville, St. Thomas More was dedicated in 1967. The Church with seating capacity of 400, was renovated 2 years ago and is cared for lovingly with the time, talent and treasure of its parishioners. In 1977, classrooms and gymnasium were added. In 1984, 300 families were registered. Today, 430 households comprise St. Thomas More (1995). Maureen Shea was hired in 1995 as director of liturgy and has been involved in music ministry since she was 16 years old. She plays the organ, leads the choirs and is a cantor at Mass. A youth choir lead by Claire Lewis, involves grade 5-12. Parish is preparing for a first visit by an archbishop to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation, which will be in April 1996 and Archbishop Daniel Buechlein will confirm more than 40 youths.
