History of St. Thomas More Continues:
(Excerpts taken from Mooresville Times, June 1969.)

Father Briggeman, was named the founding Priest in May 1967. He lived in a trailer behind the Church. Father Briggeman was a long standing pipe organ enthusiast and after months of planning, he began the construction of a unique 18 century sounding pipe organ. It was finished by Easter in 1969. Father Briggeman was transferred in July 1971. Father Moriarity was assigned July 1971 and he was transferred in July 1972. During 1972 the parking lot was paved.

The first Baptism took place in July 1967 and the first marriage was in January 1968. In 1976 the two statues, one of St. Joseph and one of the Blessed Virgin Mary, were added to the Church. Father Head had acquired them from the convent chapel at St. Thomas Aquinas when it was dismantled. Father Head supervised the building of the first rectory in 1974, but he did not get to live in it. Father Head established our first Board of Education. He was transferred in July 1974. Father Voelker moved into the rectory in July 1974 and was priest until 1976. The first Eucharistic Ministers were appointed during Father Voelker's time at St. Thomas More. (Look for more history/trivia in next week's bulletin.)
